We are terrified by punishment, and if we're terrified, our love isn't at its best.

D The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke, the sixteenth chapter.

<sup>19</sup>“There was a rich man who dressed in purple and fine linen and lived in luxury every day. <sup>20</sup>A beggar by the name of Lazarus was laid at his gate. He was covered with sores <sup>21</sup>and longed to satisfy his hunger with anything that might fall from the rich man’s table. And the dogs would even come and lick his sores.

<sup>22</sup>“One day the beggar died, and the angels carried him to Abraham’s side. The rich man also died and was buried. <sup>23</sup>Being tormented in hell, he looked up, and though far away, he saw Abraham, and Lazarus at his side. <sup>24</sup>‘Father Abraham,’ he called, ‘have pity on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool off my tongue, because I’m suffering in this fire.’

<sup>25</sup>“But Abraham said, ‘Remember, son, you had your good things in your life, while Lazarus had his misery. Now he is comforted here, while you’re suffering. <sup>26</sup>And besides all these things, there’s a wide chasm fixed between us and you, so that those who might want to cross from here over to you can’t do it, nor do any from there come over to us.’

<sup>27</sup>“‘Then I ask you, father,’ he said, ‘send him to my father’s home — <sup>28</sup>I have five brothers — to warn them not to get into this place of torture.’

<sup>29</sup>“‘They have Moses and the prophets,’ Abraham said. ‘They should listen to them.’

<sup>30</sup>“‘No, Father Abraham,’ he said, ‘but if someone comes to them from the dead, they’ll repent.’

<sup>31</sup>“‘If they don’t listen to Moses and the prophets,’ he answered him, ‘they won’t be convinced even if someone rose from the dead.’ ”
