Epistle 🧇 1 Corinthians 12:1-11

¹Fellow Christians, I want you to know about the gifts of the Spirit. ²You know that when you were unbelievers, you were led away in one way or another to idols that cannot talk. ³So I tell you that no one who is speaking by God's Spirit will say, "Jesus is cursed," and no one is able to say, "Jesus is the Lord", except by the Holy Spirit.
