<sup>4</sup> "Tell them, 'the LORD says: If men fall, can't they get up? If one goes away, can't he come back?"

<sup>5</sup> Why do these people of Jerusalem turn away and desert Me forever? They cling to deception. They refuse to return.

<sup>6</sup> I paid attention and listened, but they don't say the right thing. No one feels sorry for his wrong saying, "What have I done?" They all run their own course, like horses charging into battle.

<sup>7</sup> Even a stork in the sky knows its seasons; a turtledove, a swallow, and a crane migrate at the right time; but My people don't know what the LORD prescribes.

<sup>8</sup> How can you say: "We are wise, and the LORD's law is with us." Surely the scholars with lying pens have made it a lie.

<sup>9</sup> Wise men are ashamed, confused, and caught. You see, they have rejected the LORD's Word, so what wisdom do they have?

<sup>10</sup> So I will give their wives to others and their fields to conquerors because all of them, small and great, are eager for dishonest money; all of them, prophet and priest, cheat.

<sup>11</sup> They heal My people's wounds superficially, saying, "All is well, all is well!" when nothing is well.

<sup>12</sup> Are they ashamed when they do detestable things? No, they aren't ashamed. They don't even know how to blush. So they will fall with those that fall. When I punish them, they will be brought down, says the LORD.

## Epistle *↪ 1 Corinthians 12:1-11*

<sup>1</sup>Fellow Christians, I want you to know about the gifts of the Spirit. <sup>2</sup>You know that when you were unbelievers, you were led away in one way or another to idols that cannot talk. <sup>3</sup>So I tell you that no one who is speaking by God's Spirit will say, "Jesus is cursed," and no one is able to say, "Jesus is the Lord", except by the Holy Spirit.

<sup>4</sup>Now gifts are given to different persons but by the same Spirit. <sup>5</sup>Ways of serving are assigned to them but by the same Lord. <sup>6</sup>Differing powers are given to them, but the same God works everything in all of them. <sup>7</sup>Now, the Spirit shows Himself to each one to make him useful. <sup>8</sup>The Spirit gives one person the ability to speak of wisdom. To another the same Spirit gives the ability to speak intelligently. <sup>9</sup>To another the same Spirit gives faith. To another that same Spirit gives the ability to heal. <sup>10</sup>Another can work miracles. Another can speak God's Word. Another can tell the true Spirit from evil spirits. Another can speak other languages. Another can tell the meaning of languages. <sup>11</sup>One and the same Spirit works all these things and gives as He wishes to each in his own way.
